

An information guide for patients aged 16 years and over and their families to help understand online proxy access at Deddington Health Centre



Online proxy access is when someone else has permission to access another person's medical record online. This helps them look after the patient and allows them to see their allergies and/or immunisations, to order repeat prescriptions and to see any appointments already booked.

Online proxy access is most beneficial to patients who need to order repeat medication for the person they are caring for.

Any patient aged 16 or over may wish to have an online proxy to help them manage their online medical record.

You will be required to provide ID for all parties involved and the Practice will also require verbal consent from the patient to ensure they are happy for any online proxy arrangements to be put in place.
